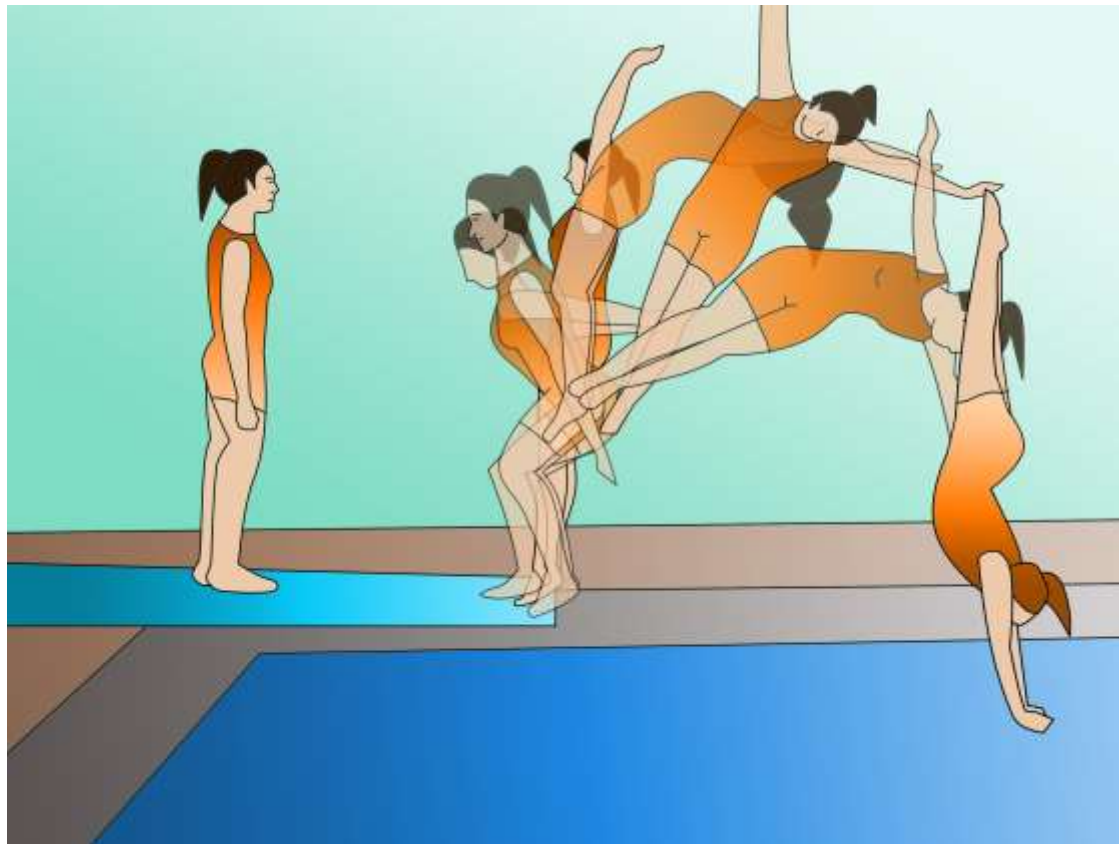

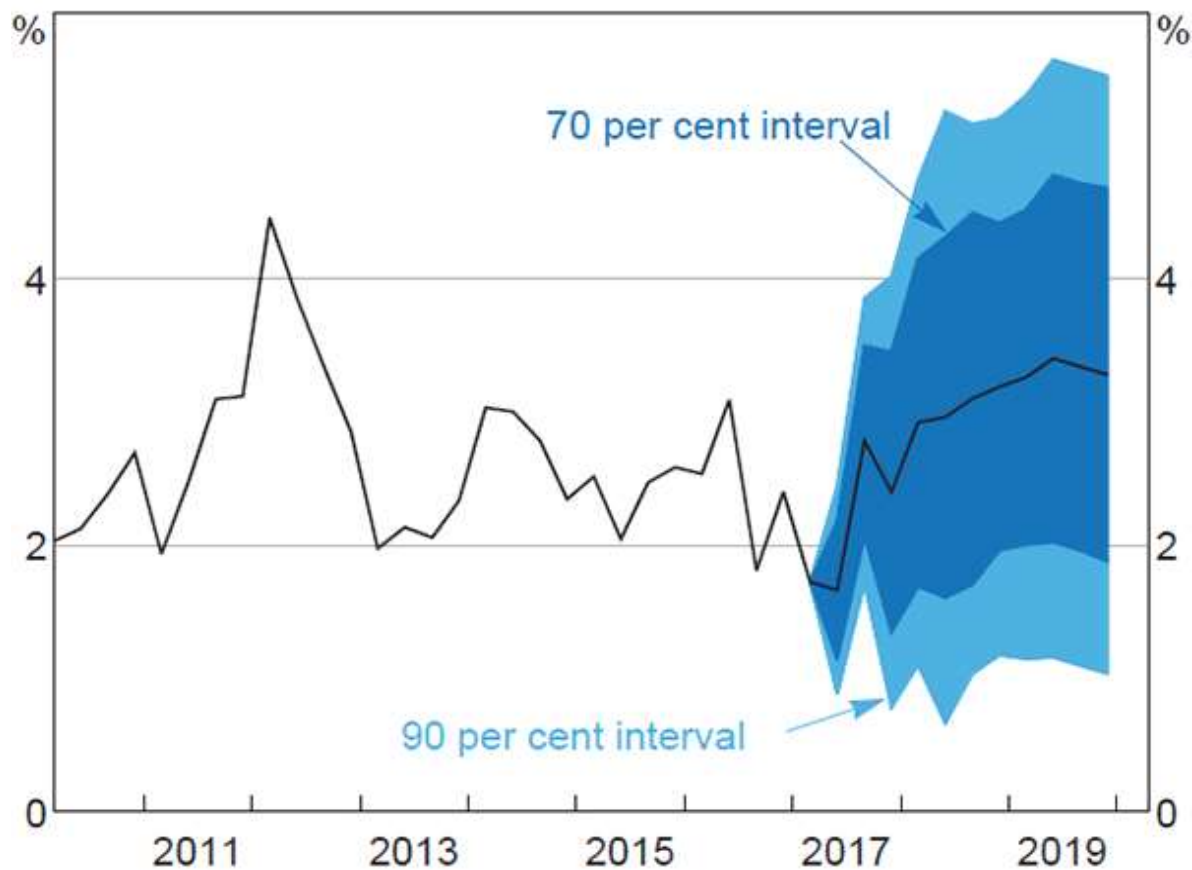


The Biggest Loser: “Whitebread” Bill

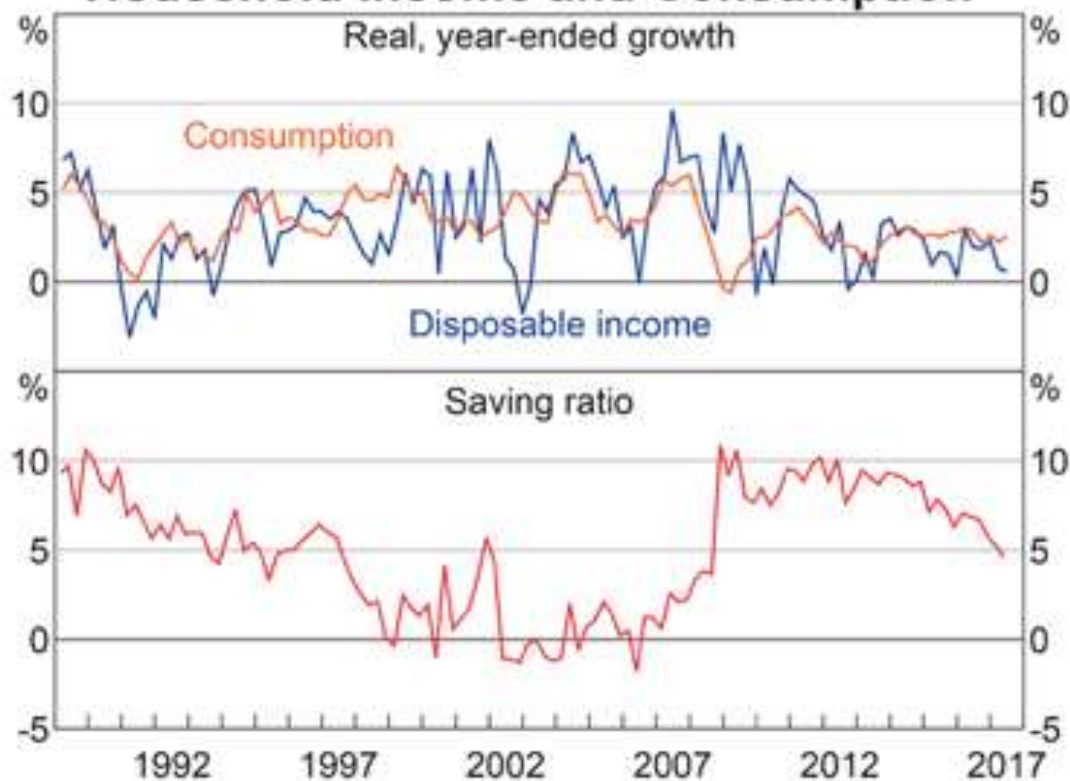

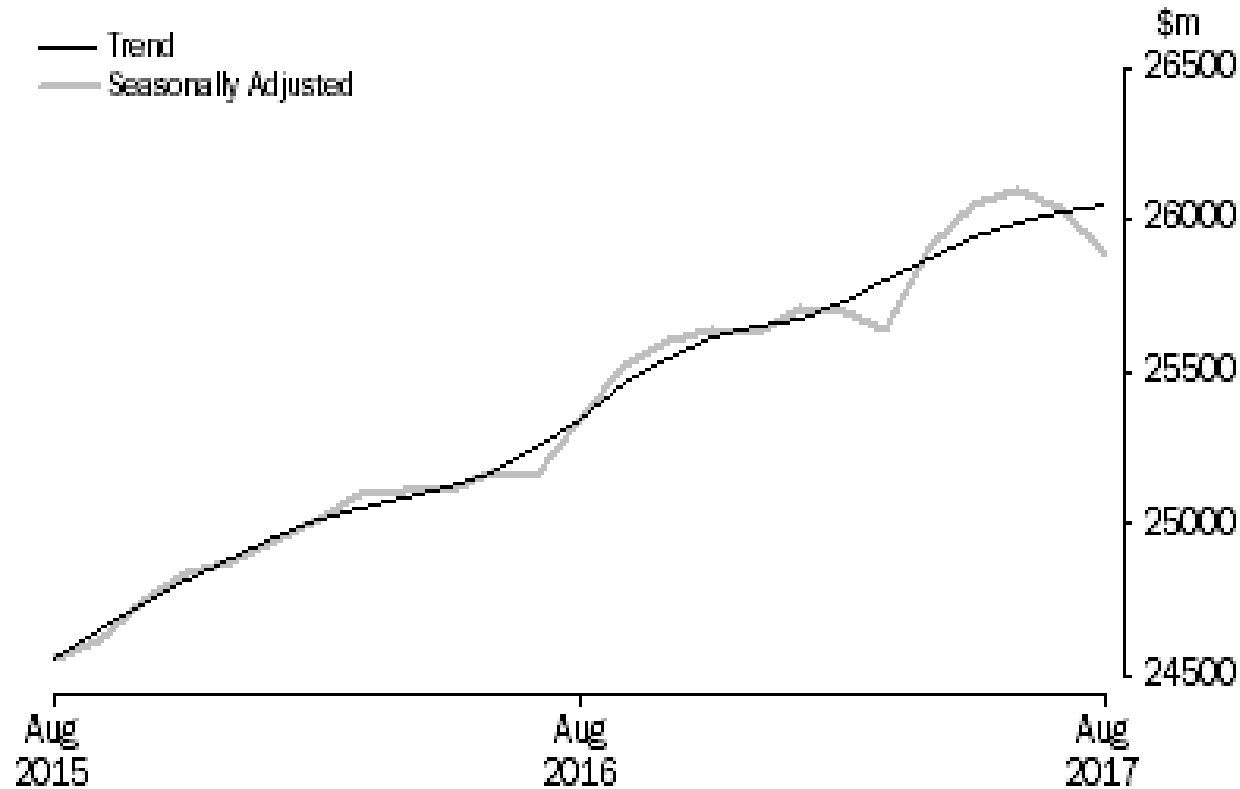
Household Income and Consumption*

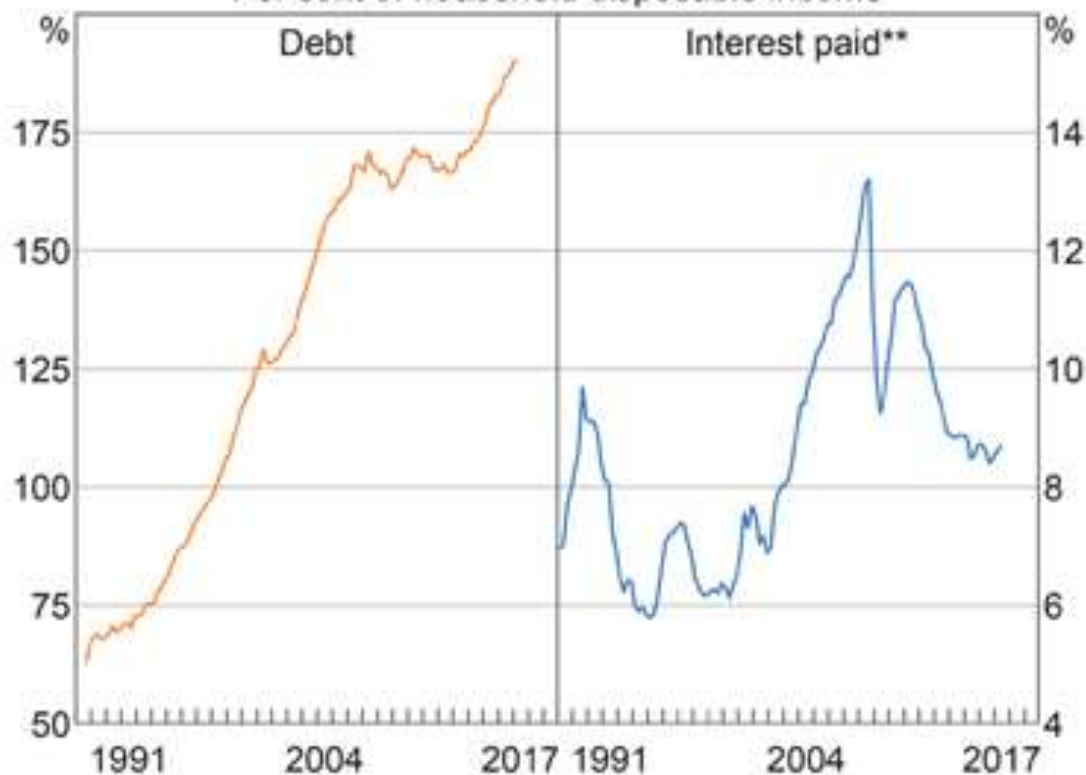

Per cent of household disposable income

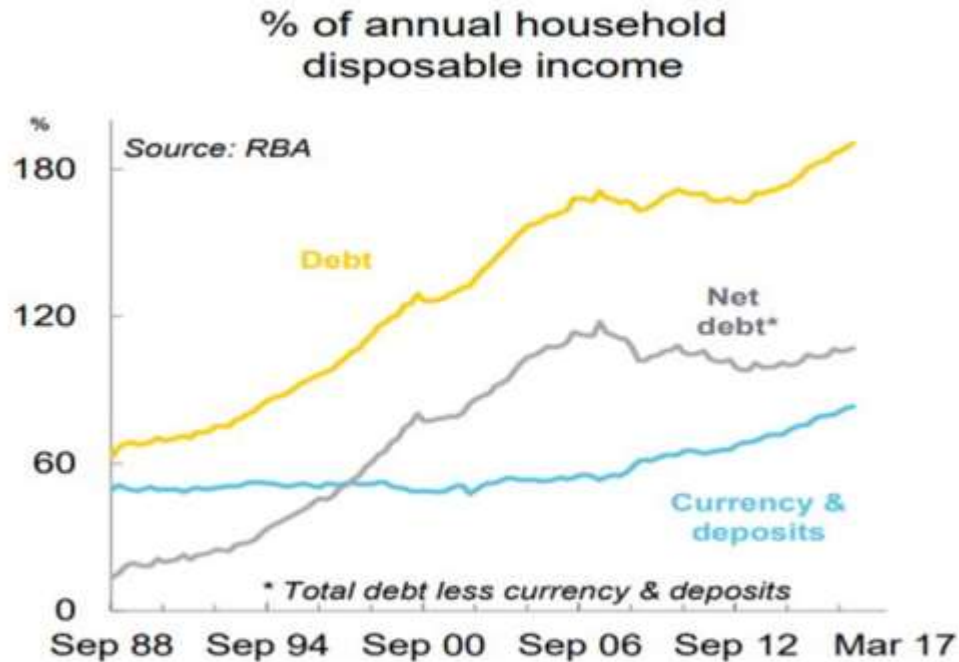

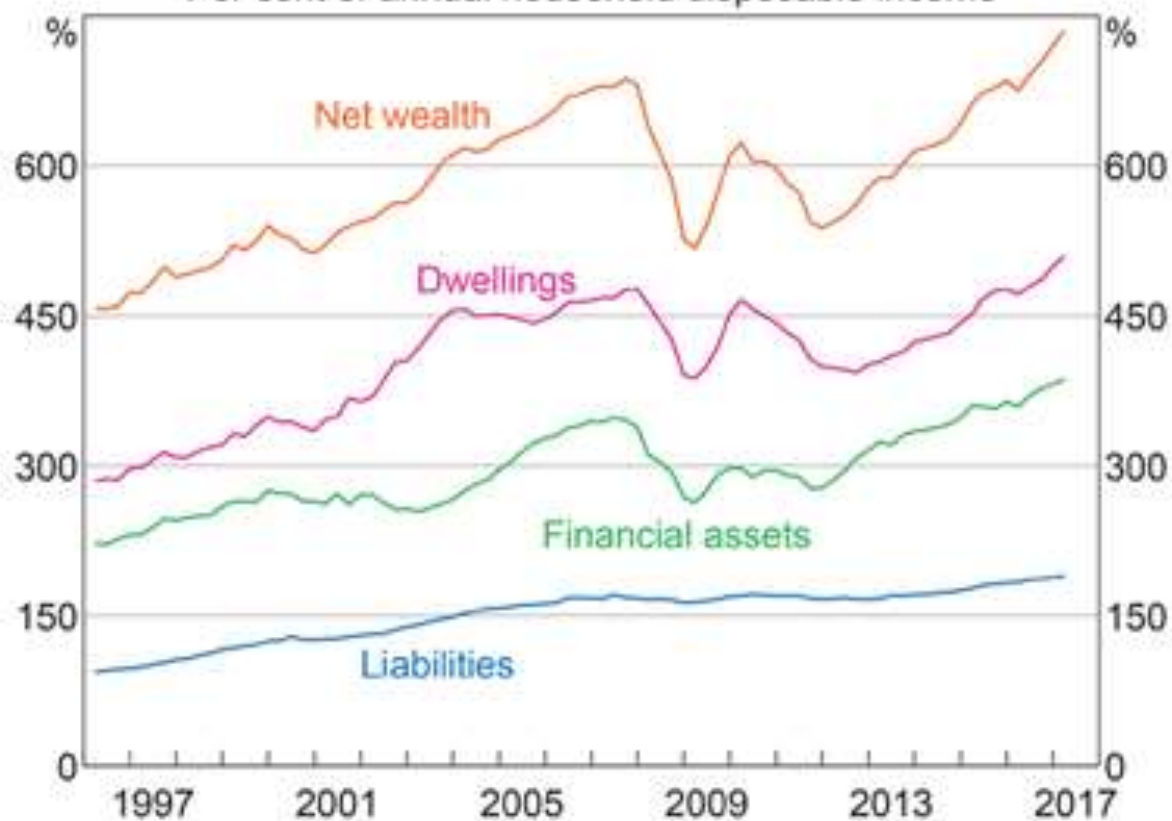
Across the system, whilst gross household debt has risen, net debt has remained stable

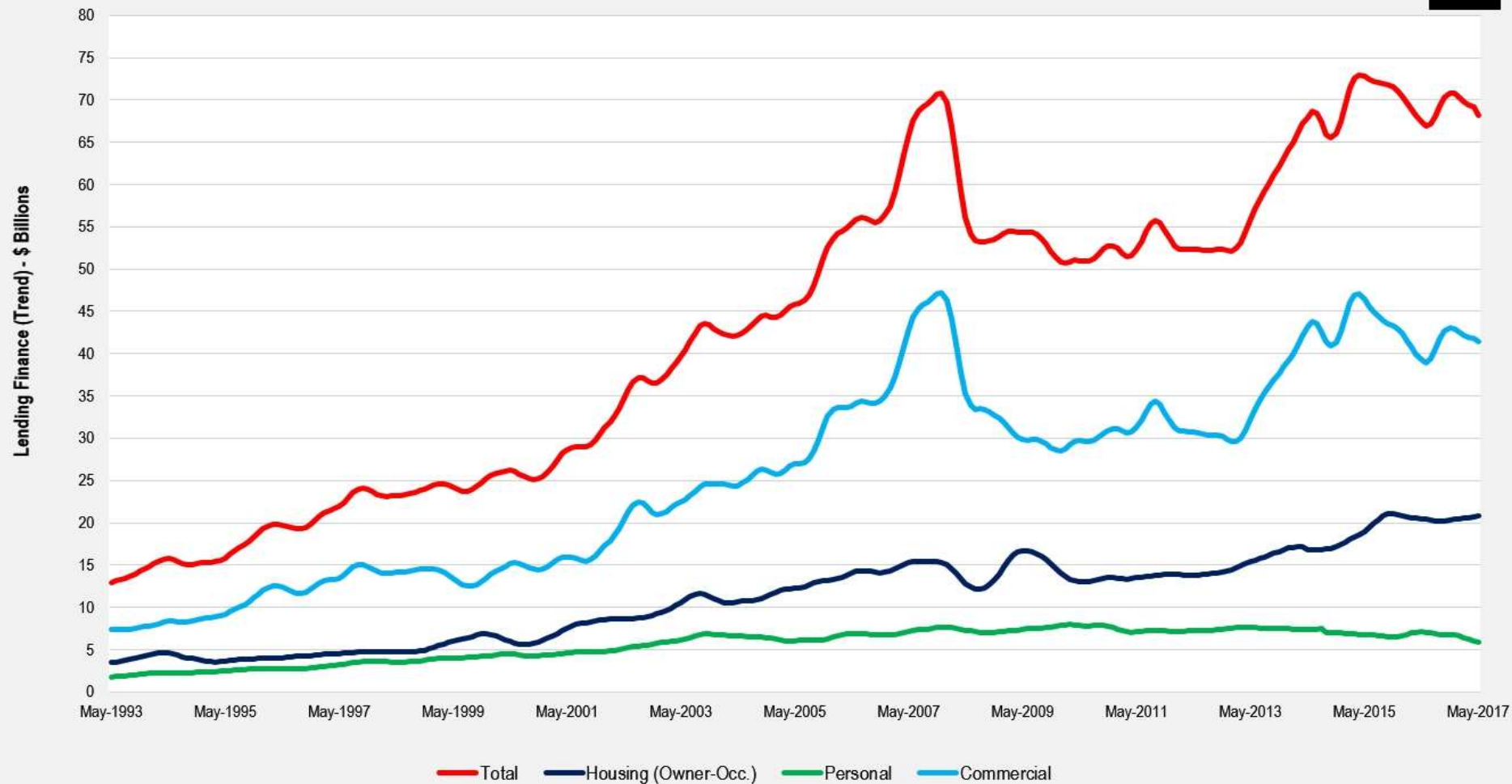
Per cent of annual household disposable income



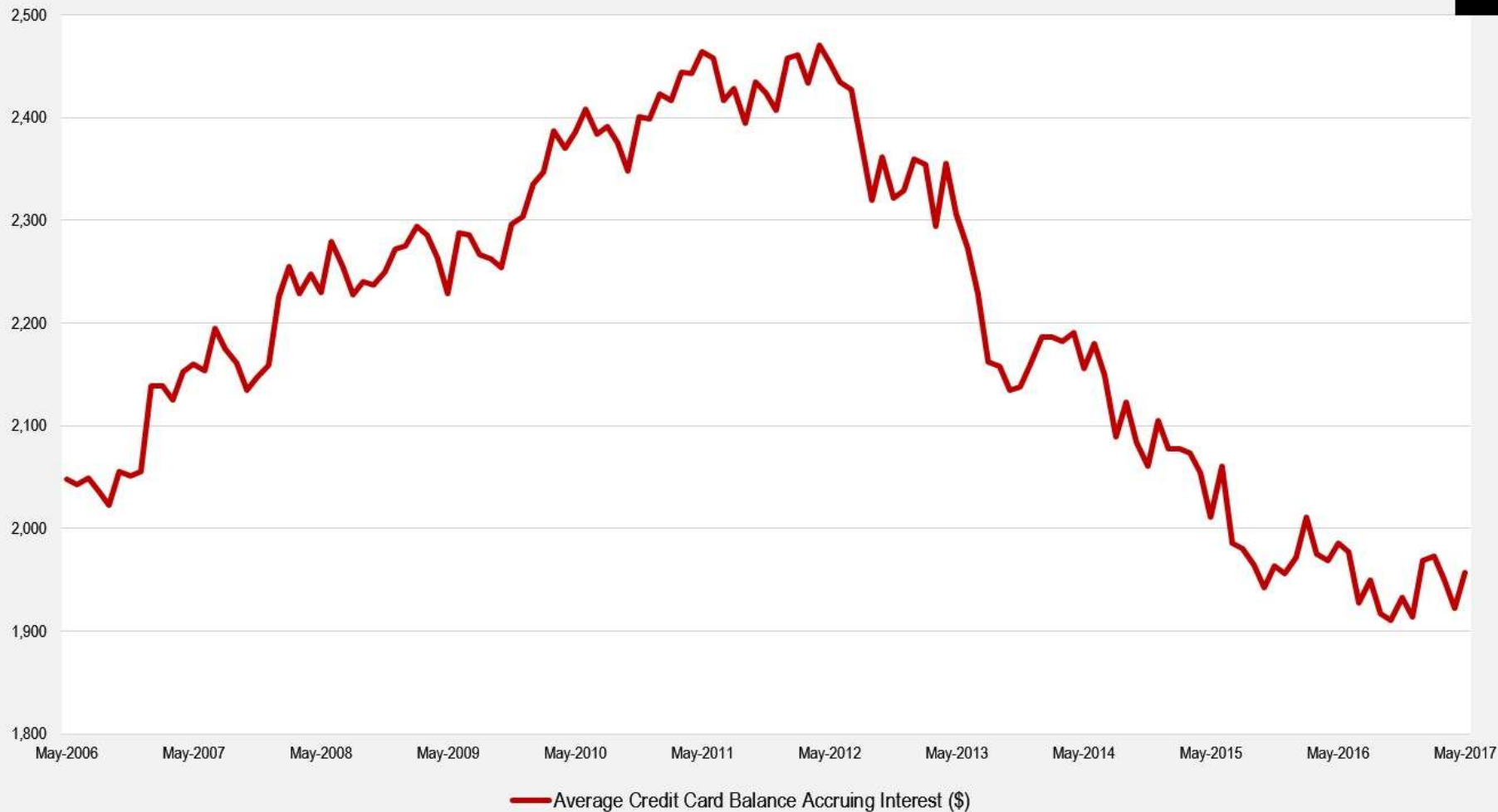

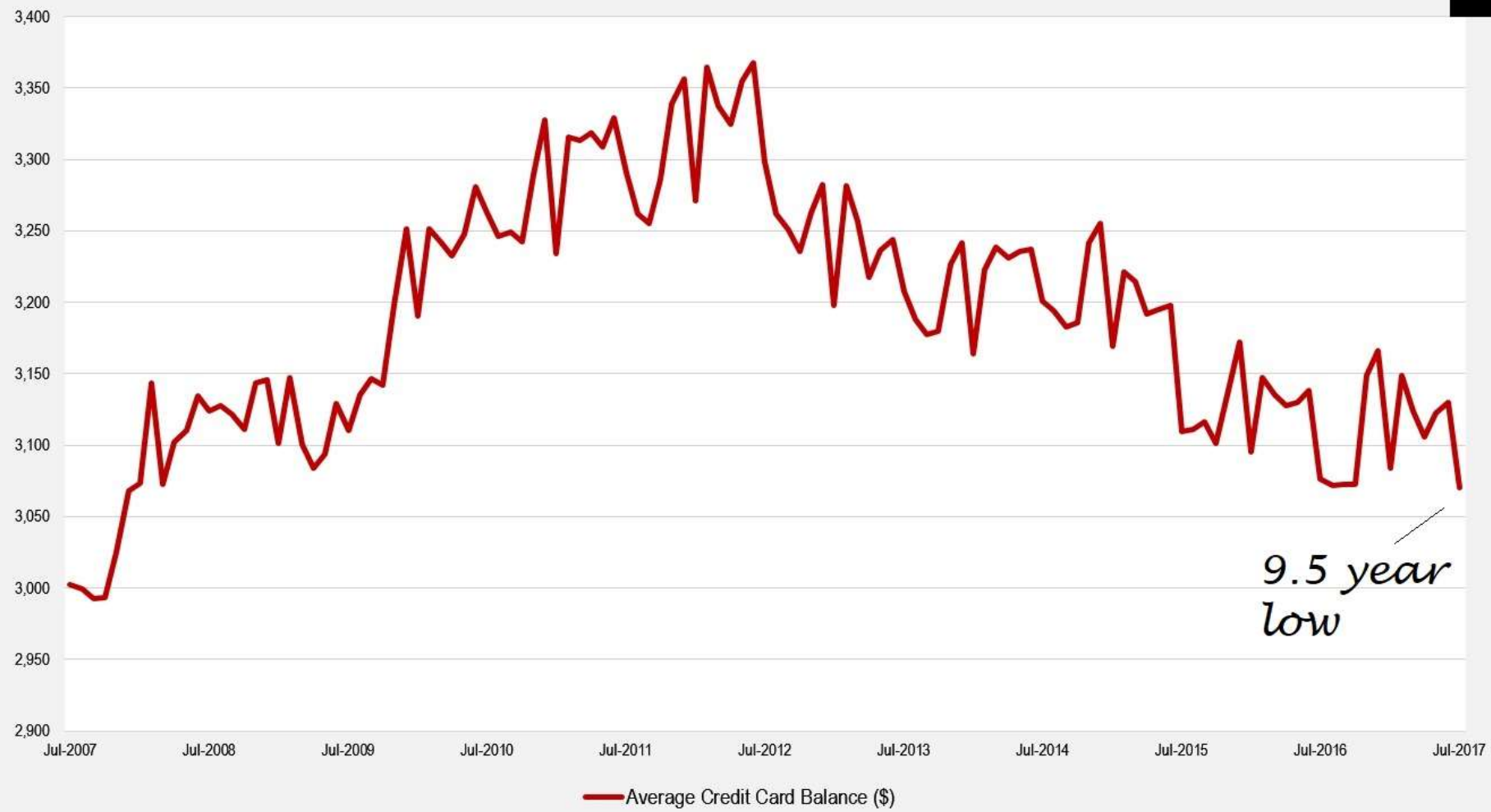
Average Credit Card Balance Accruing Interest





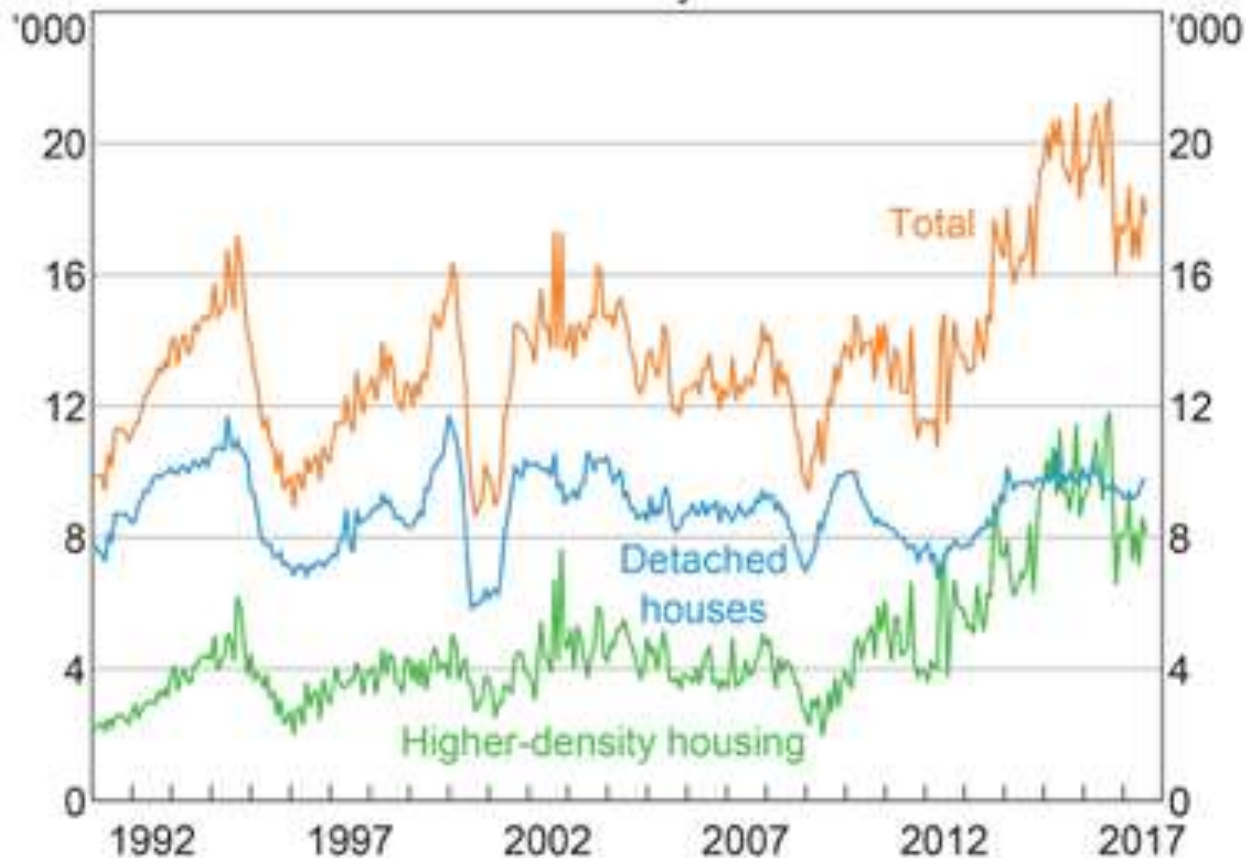

Government revenue and expenditure



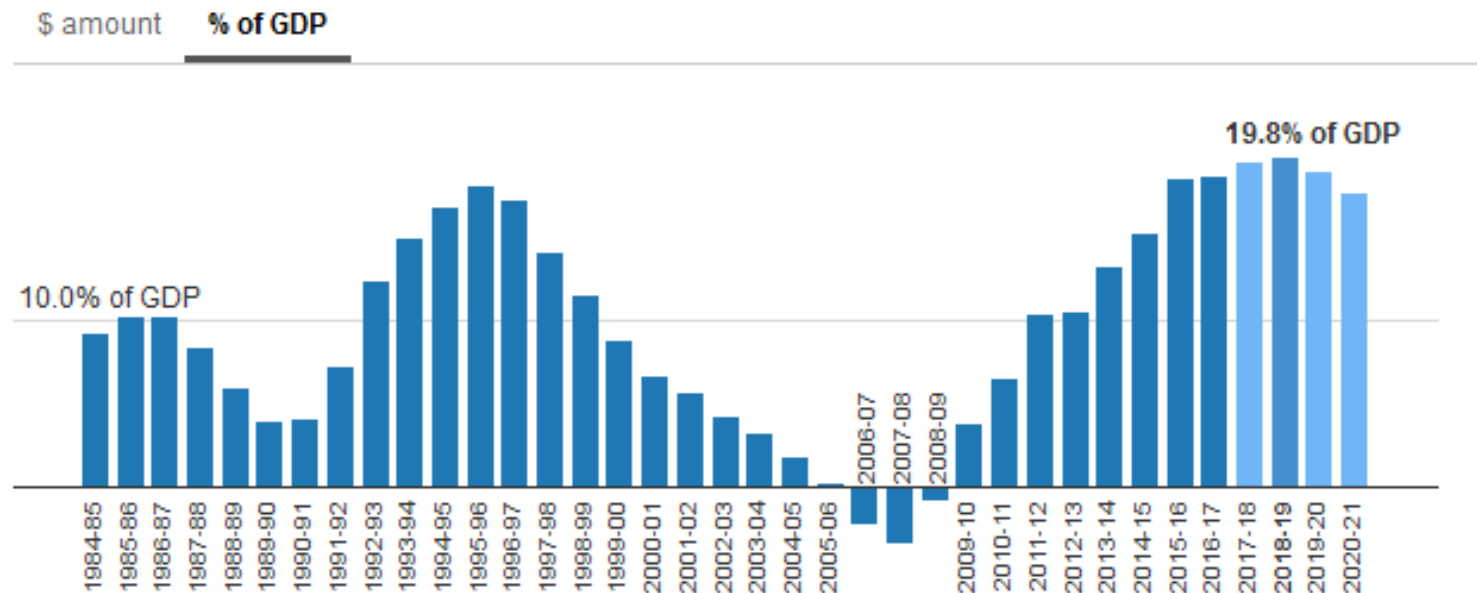

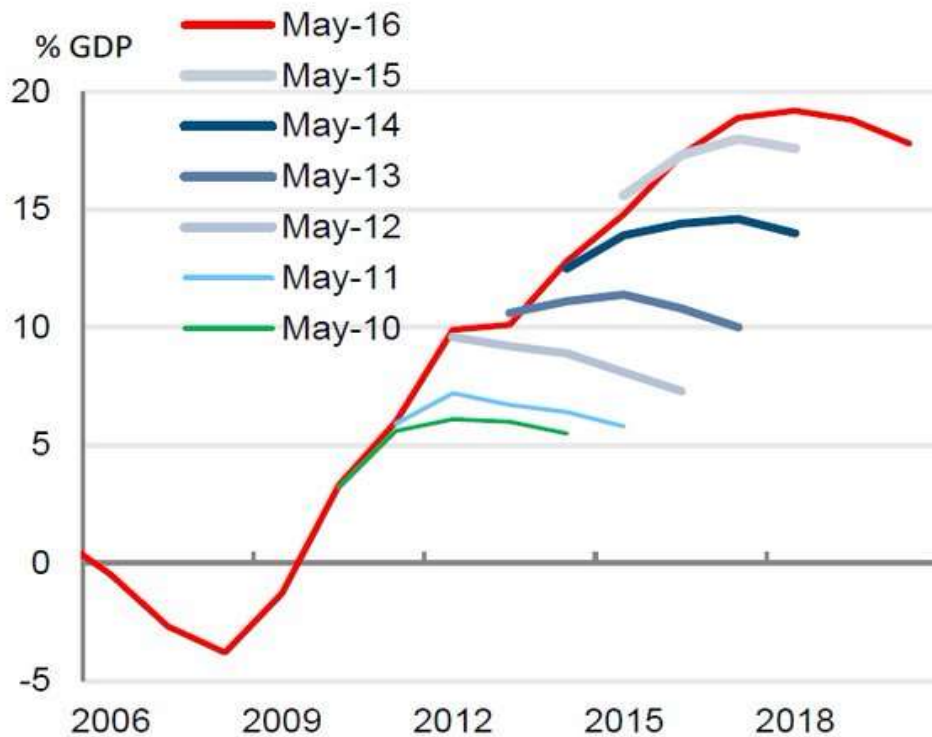

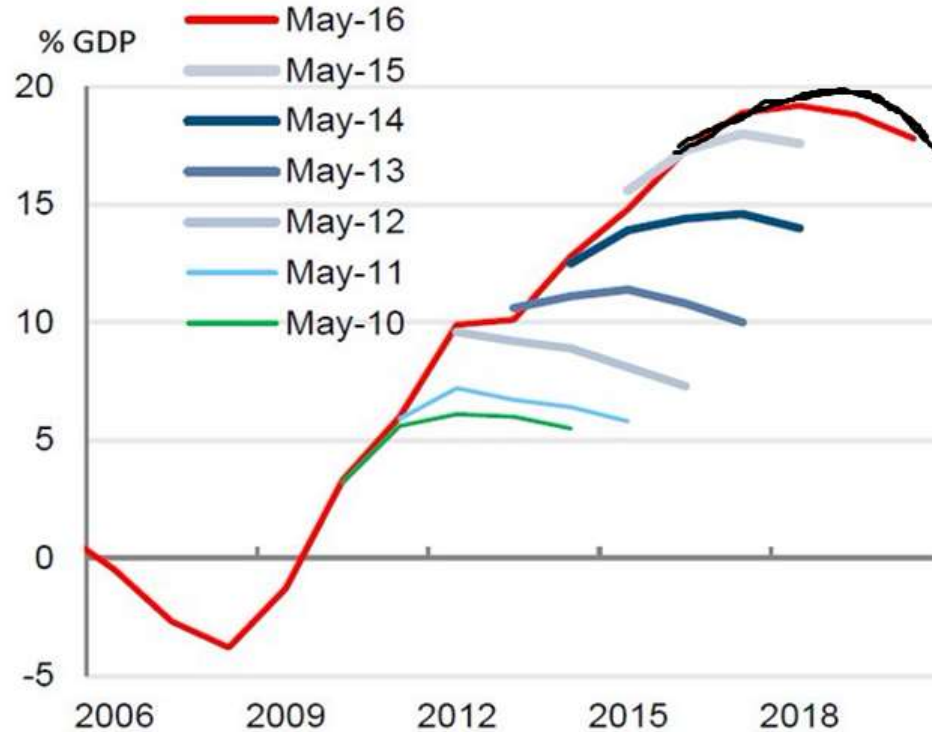
Figure 6: Successive Budget Forecasts of net Debt (Treasury definition)

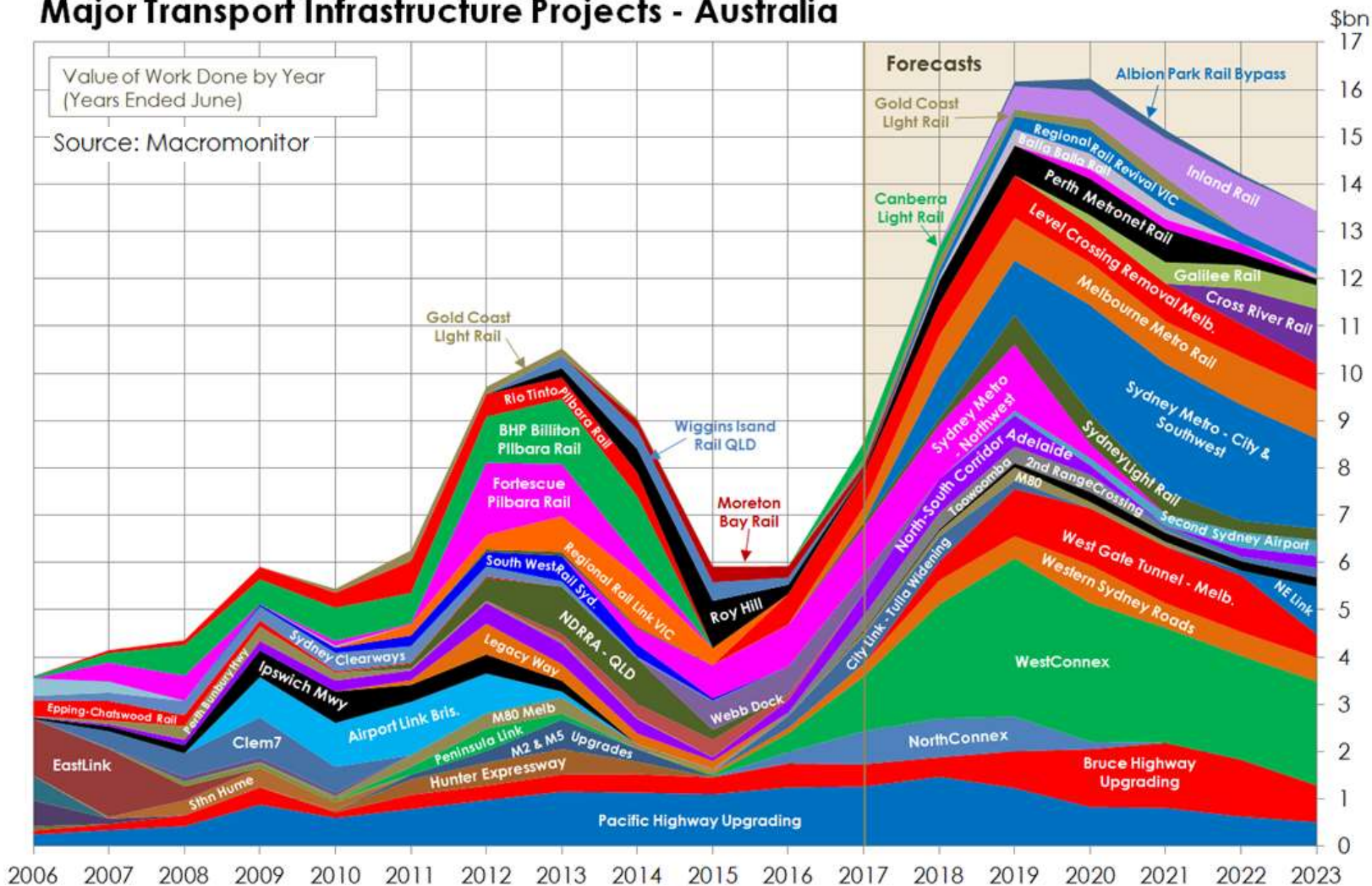

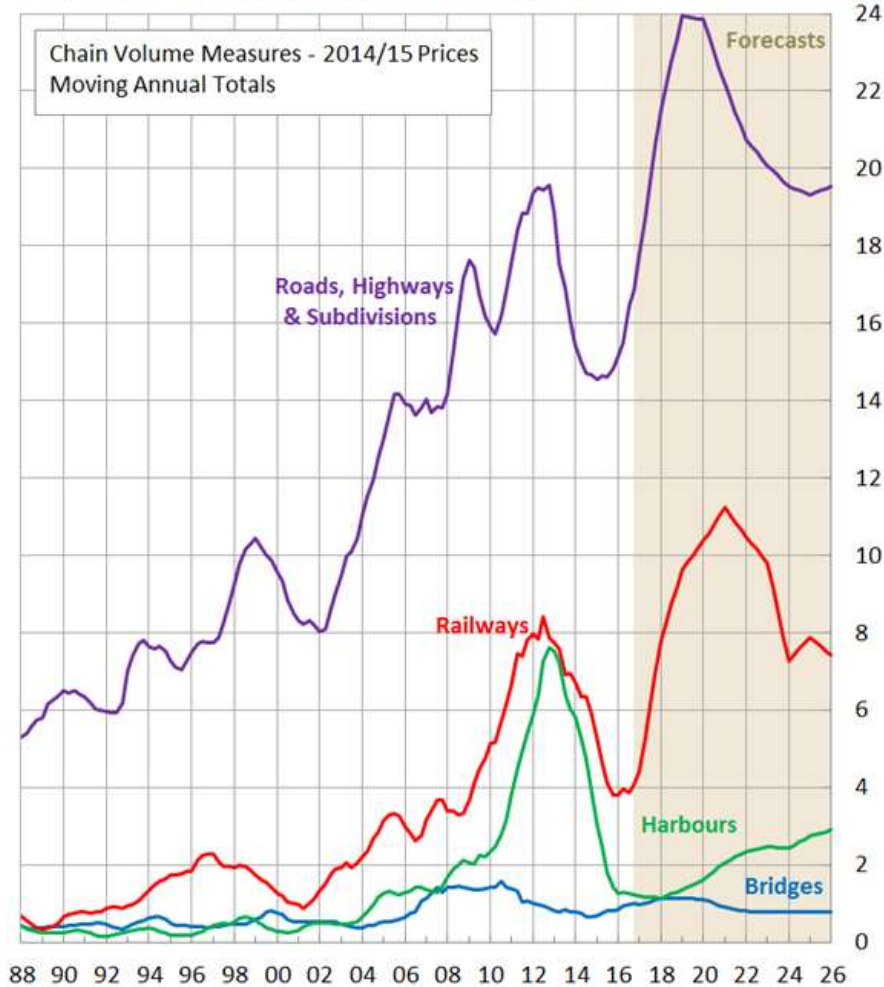
Major Transport Infrastructure Projects - Australia

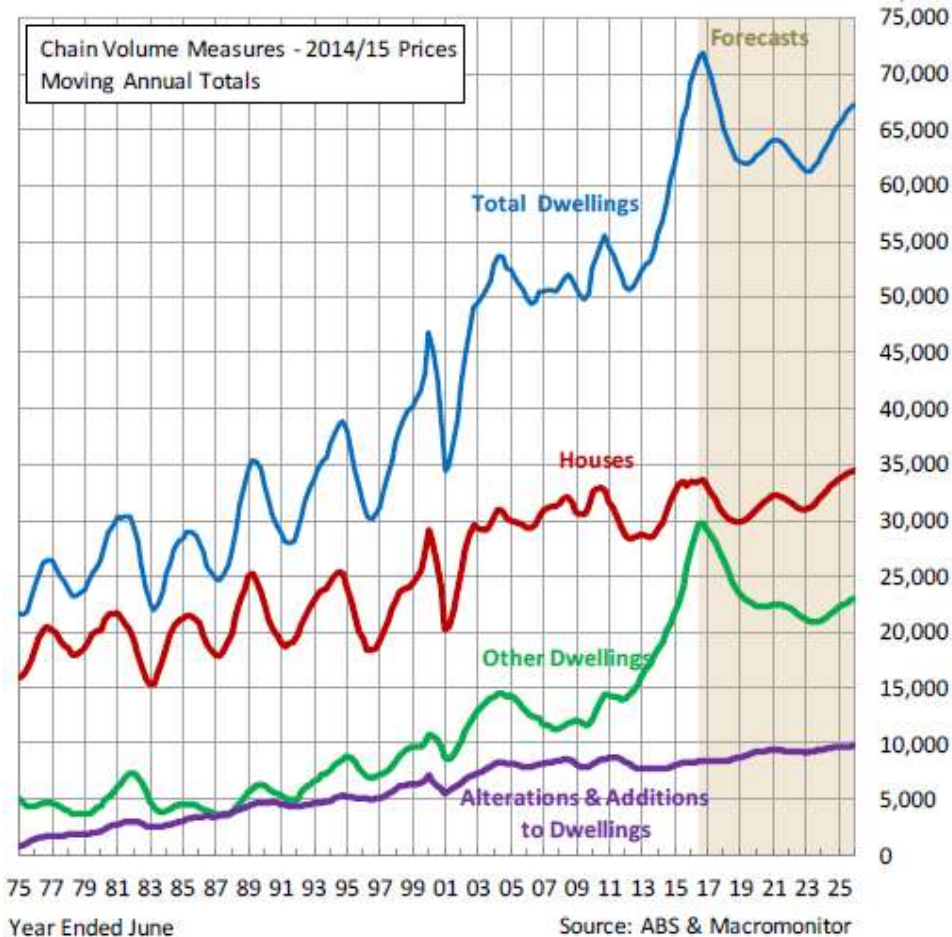


Transport Infrastructure Construction - Australia

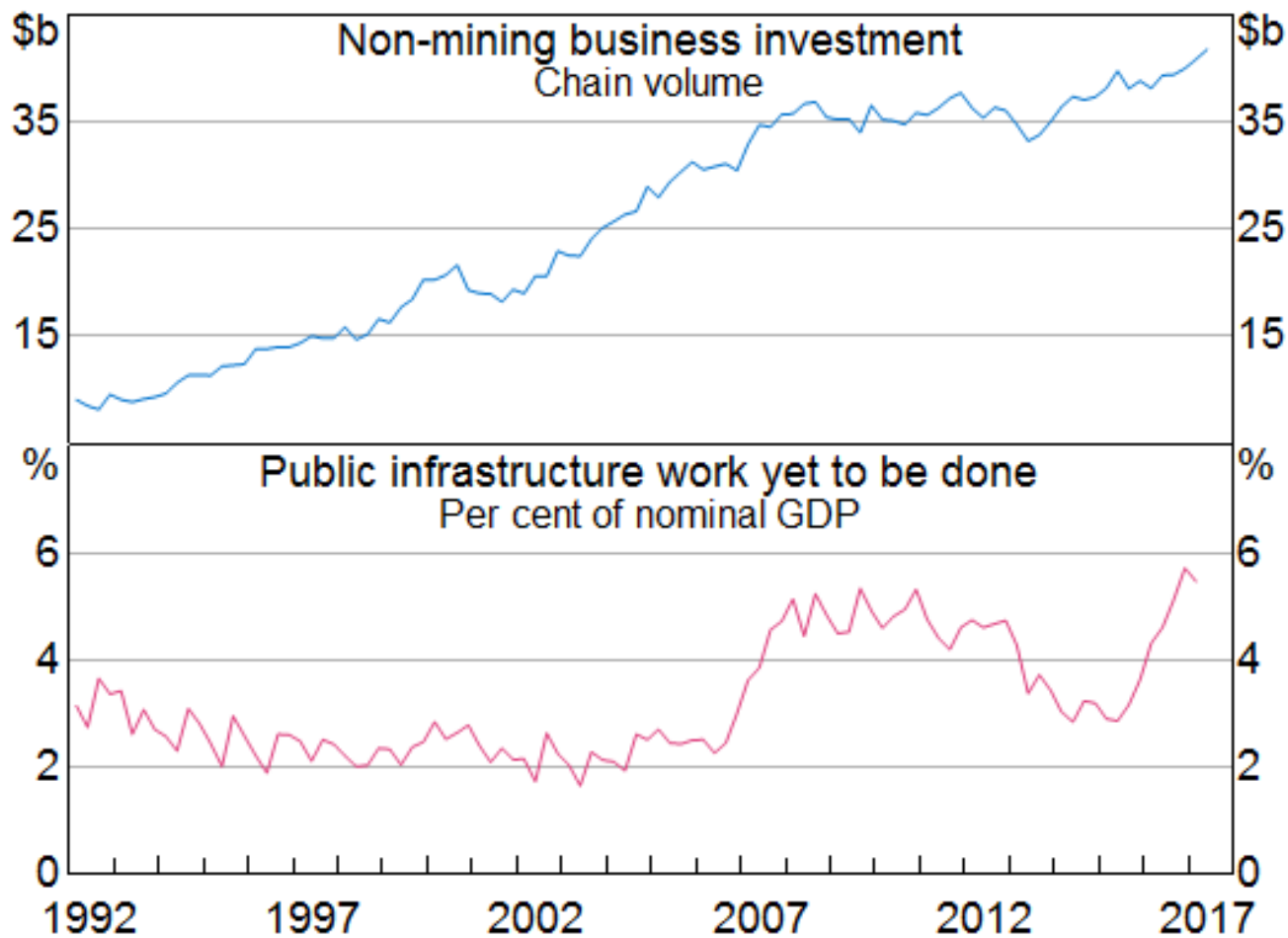

Residential Construction Work Done - Australia

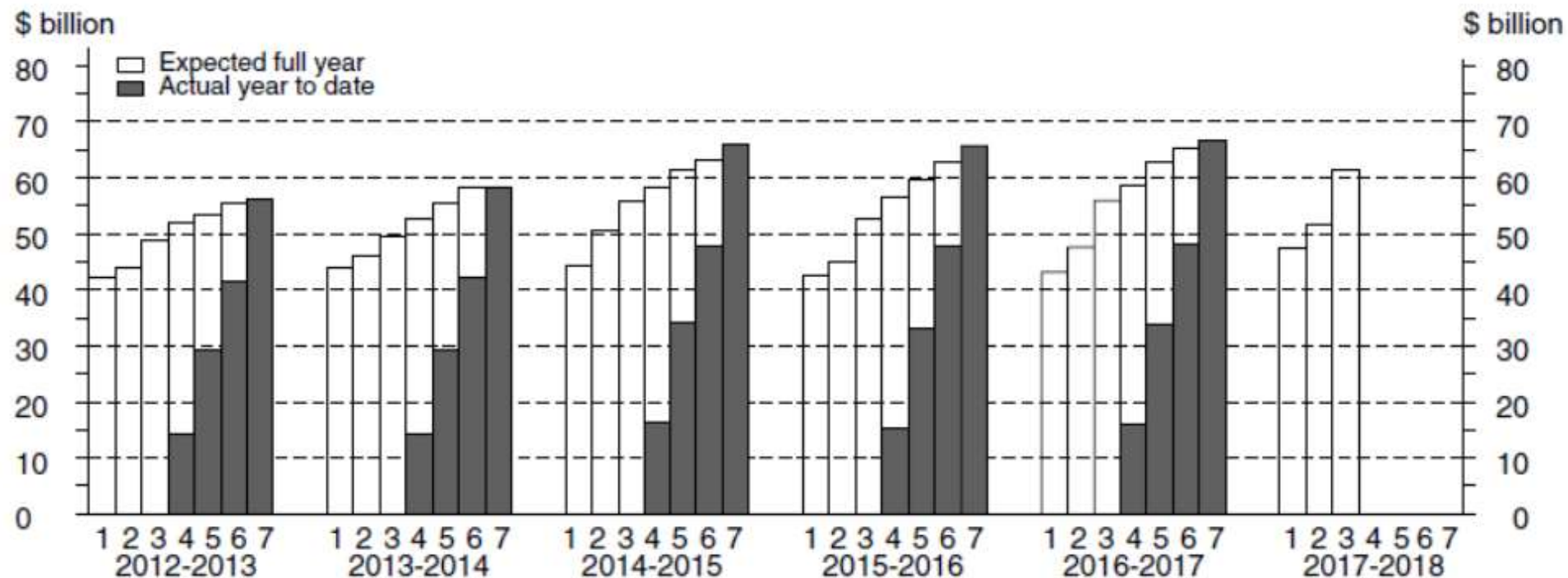

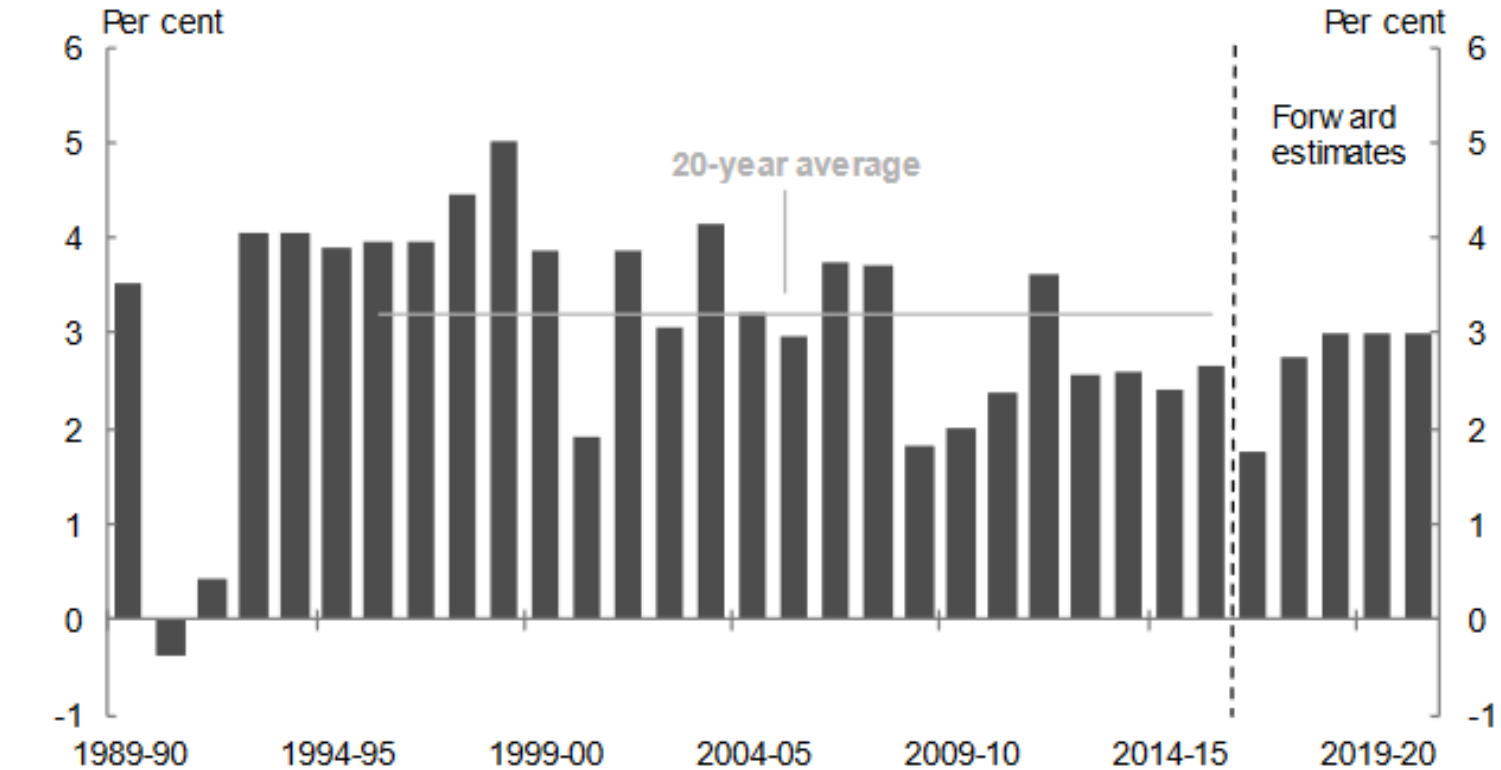

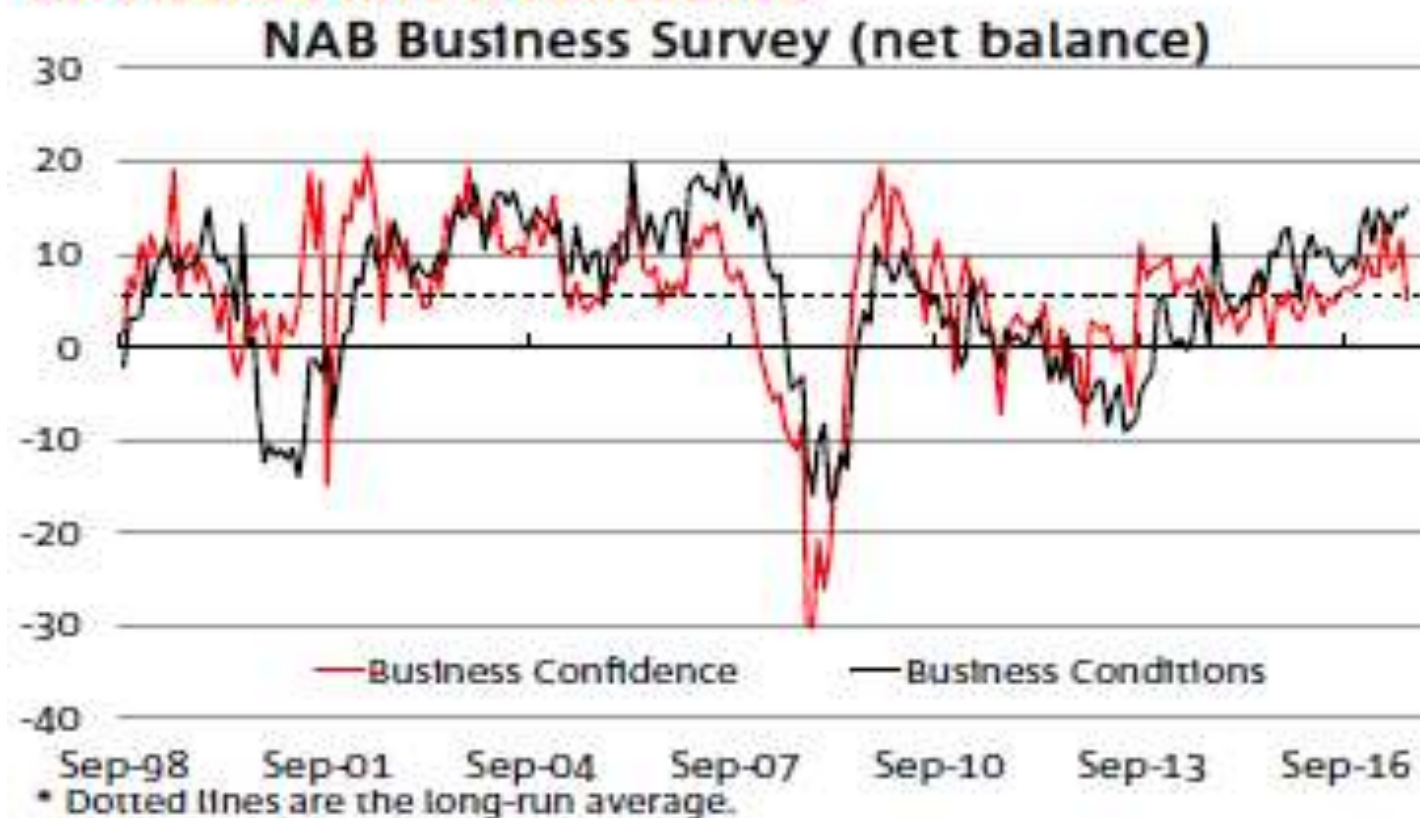
Australia: World economic champion

Chart 1: Real GDP growth

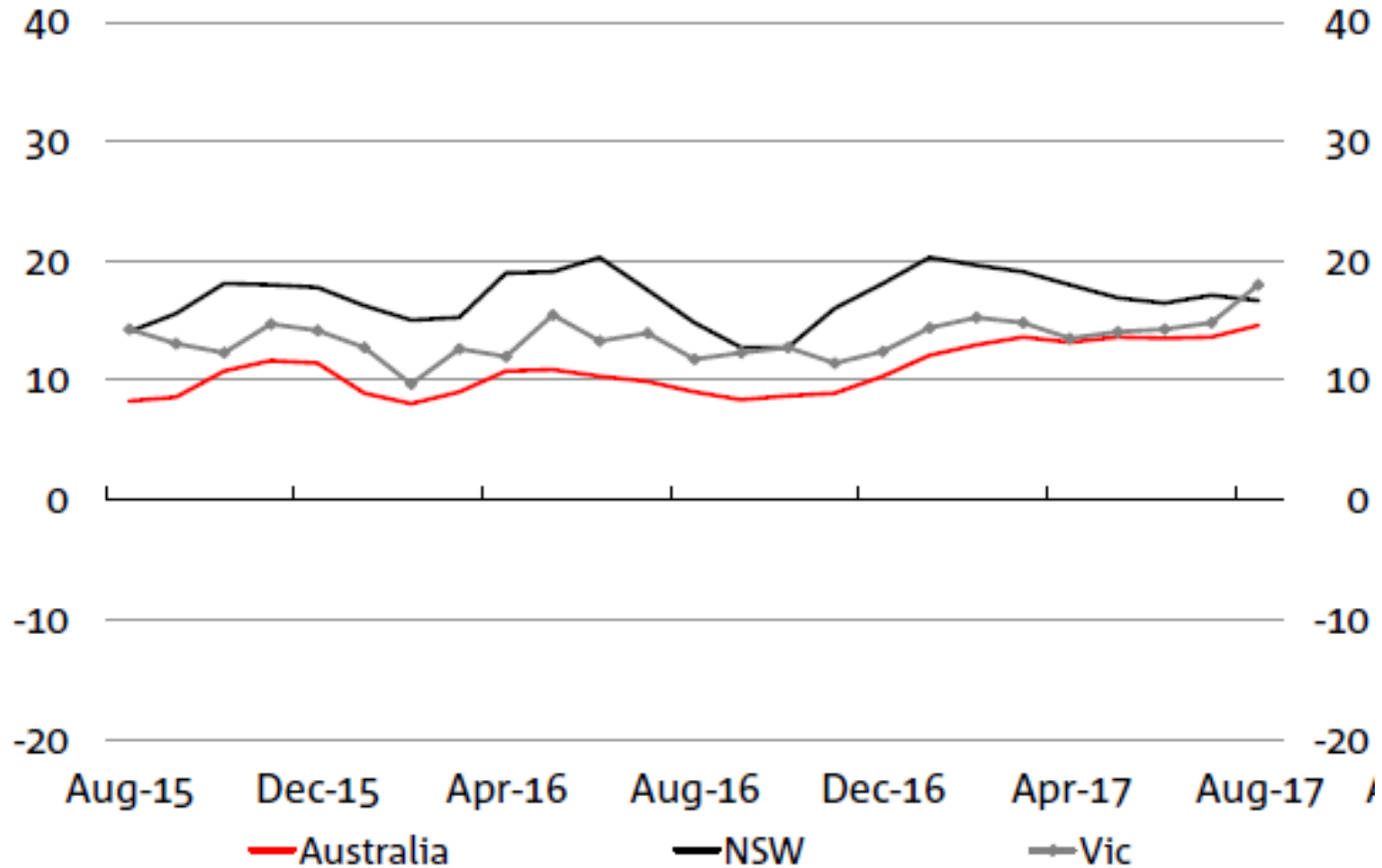

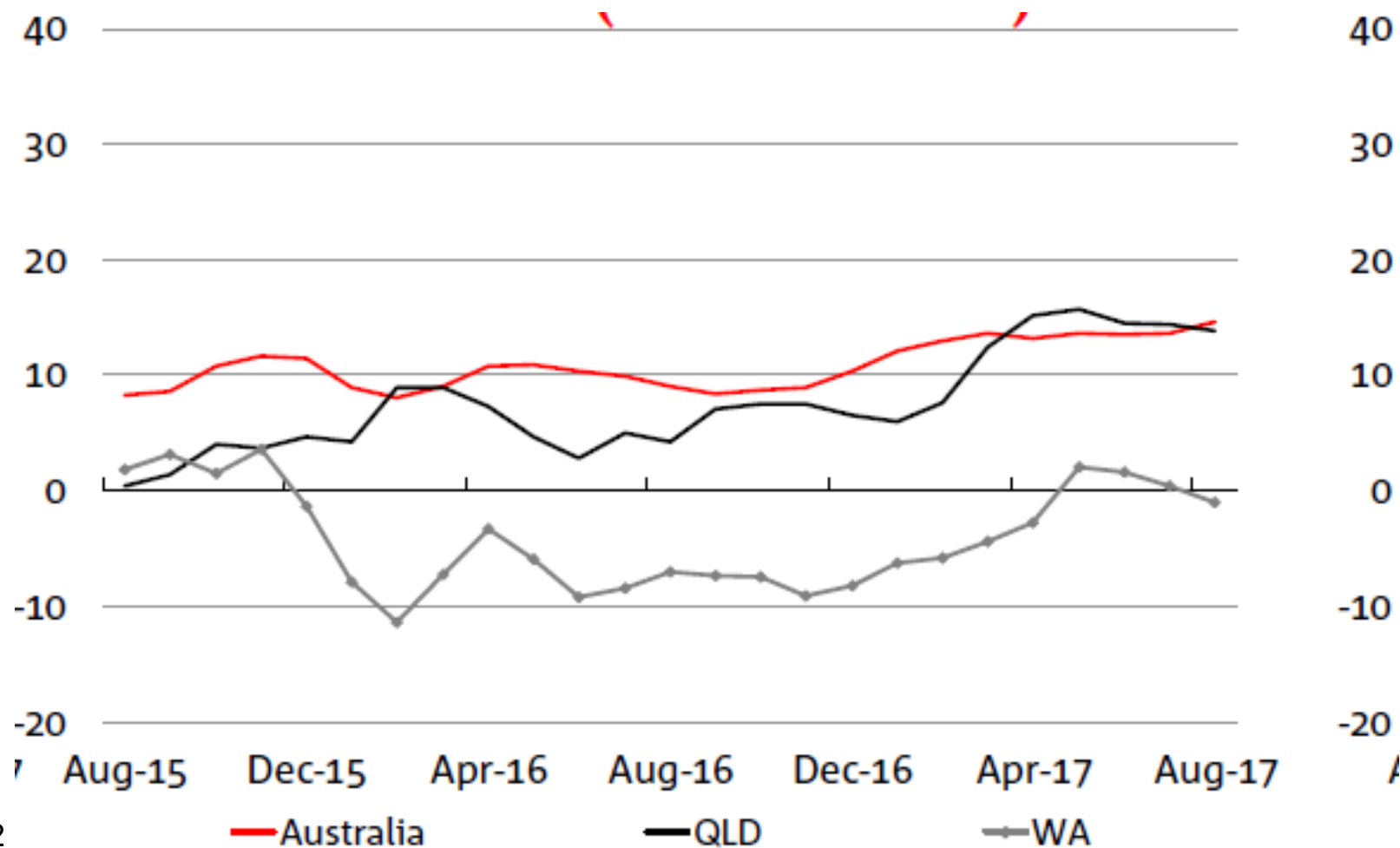

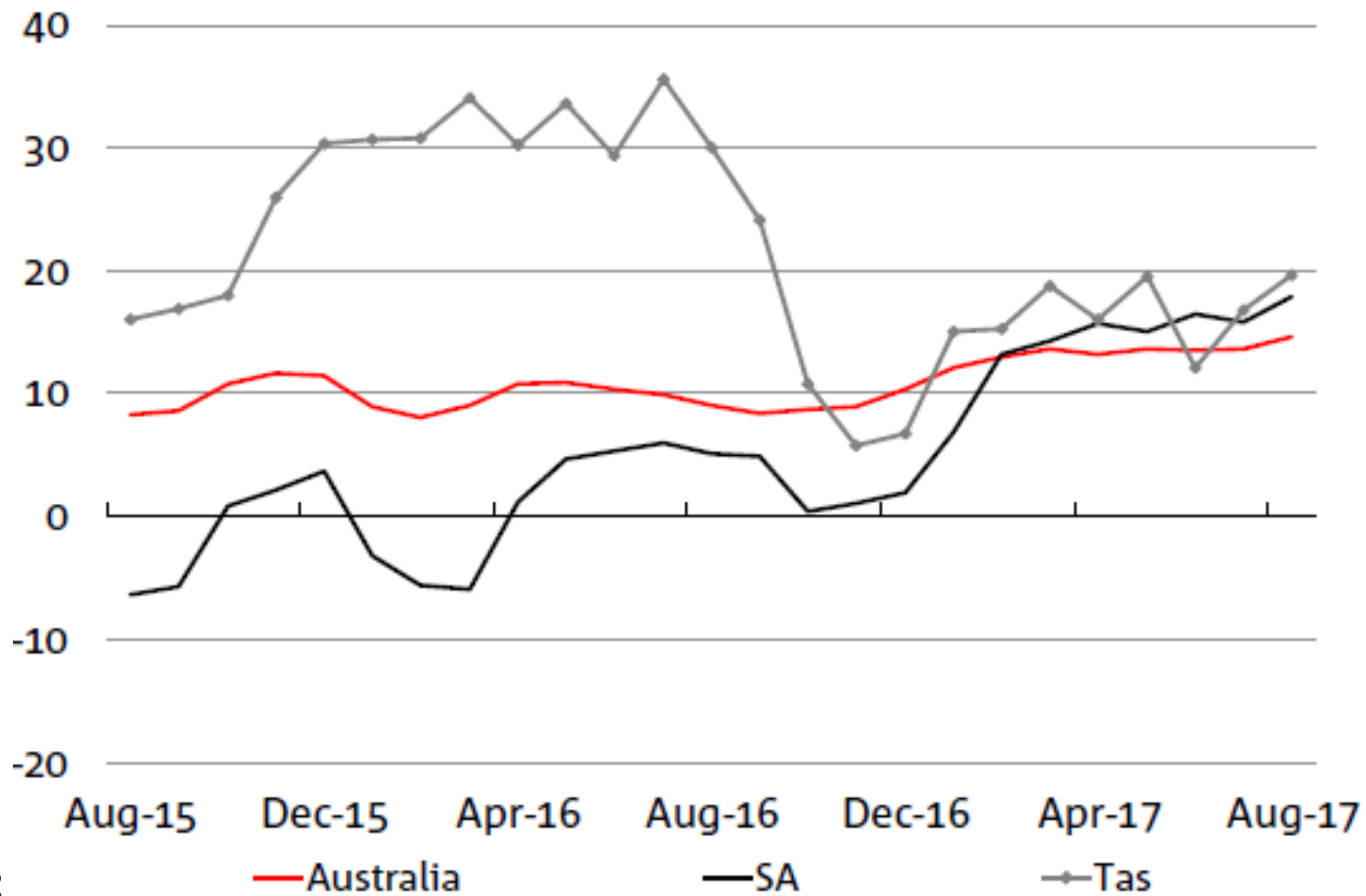

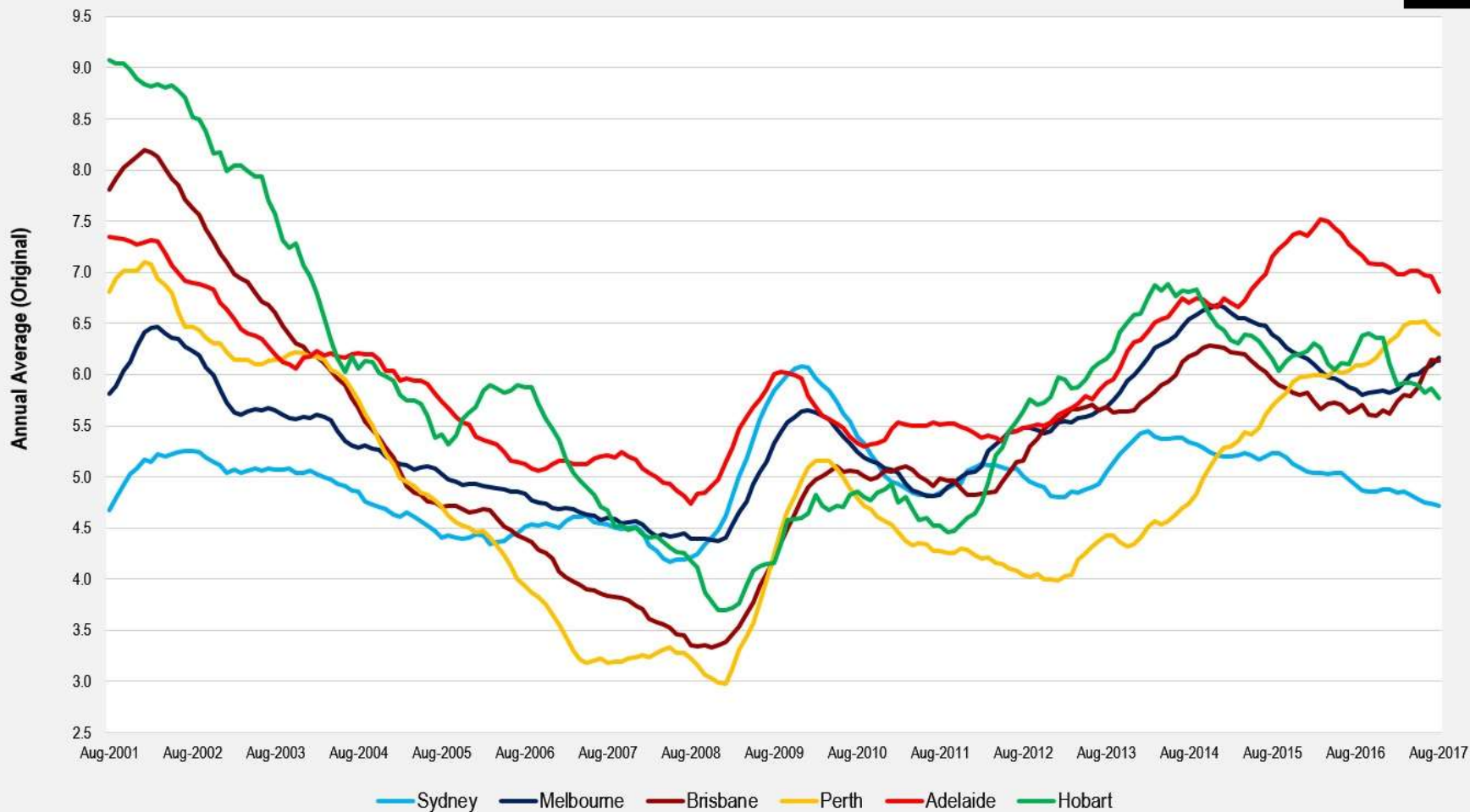

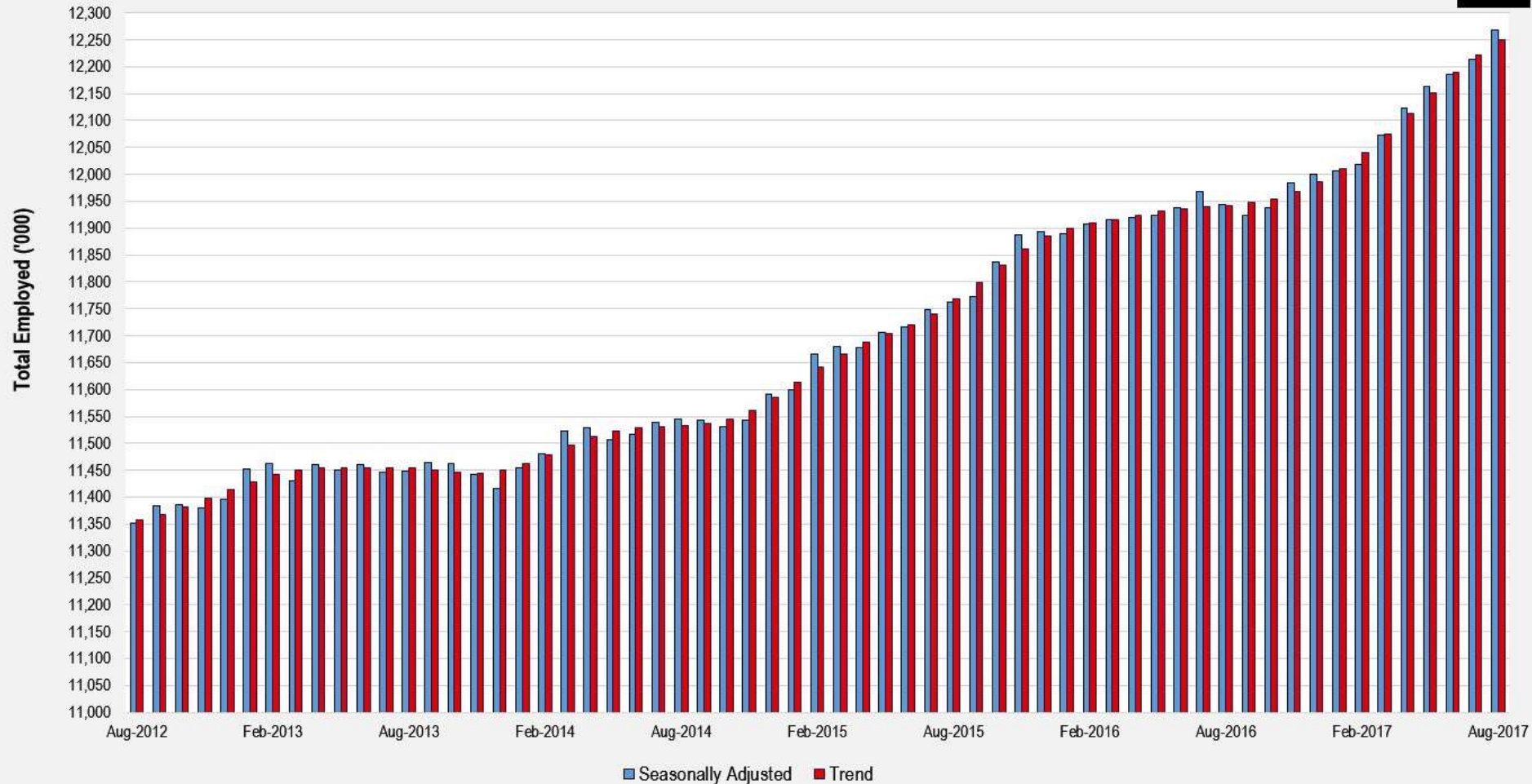

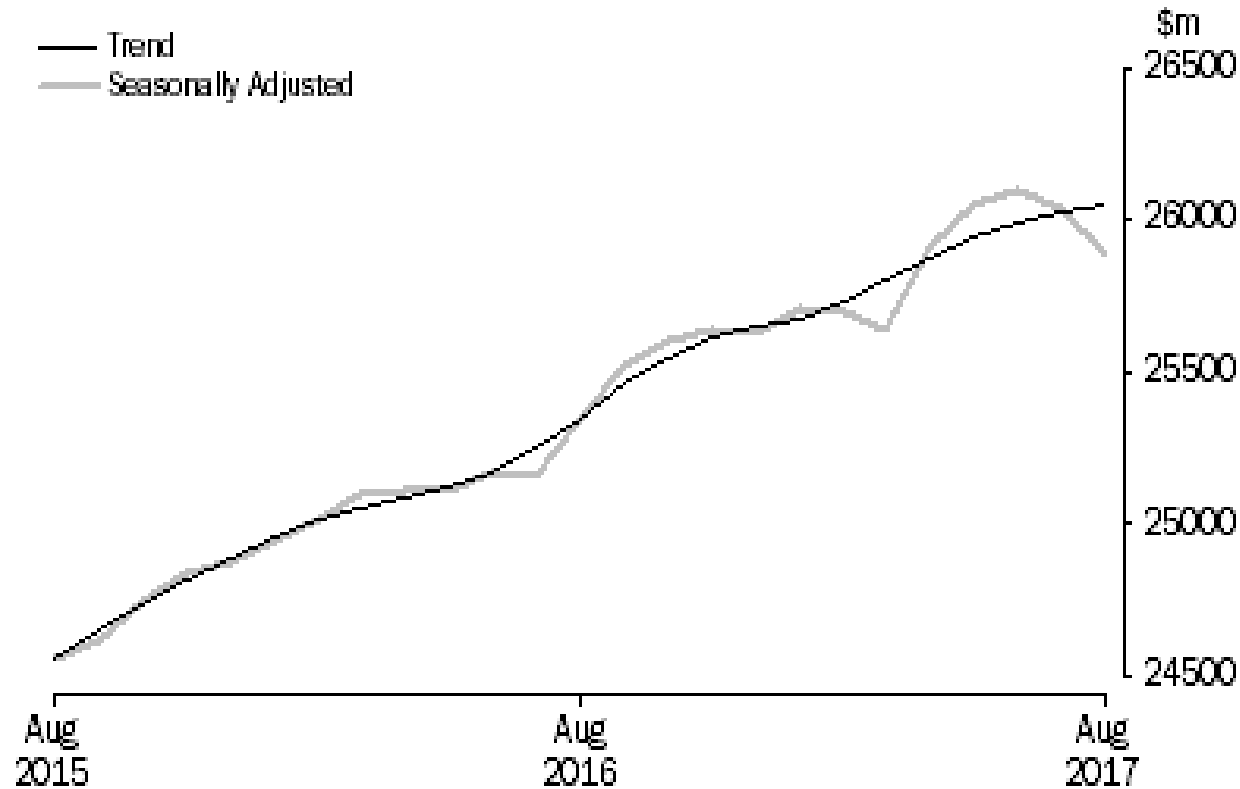
Capital City Unemployment Rates



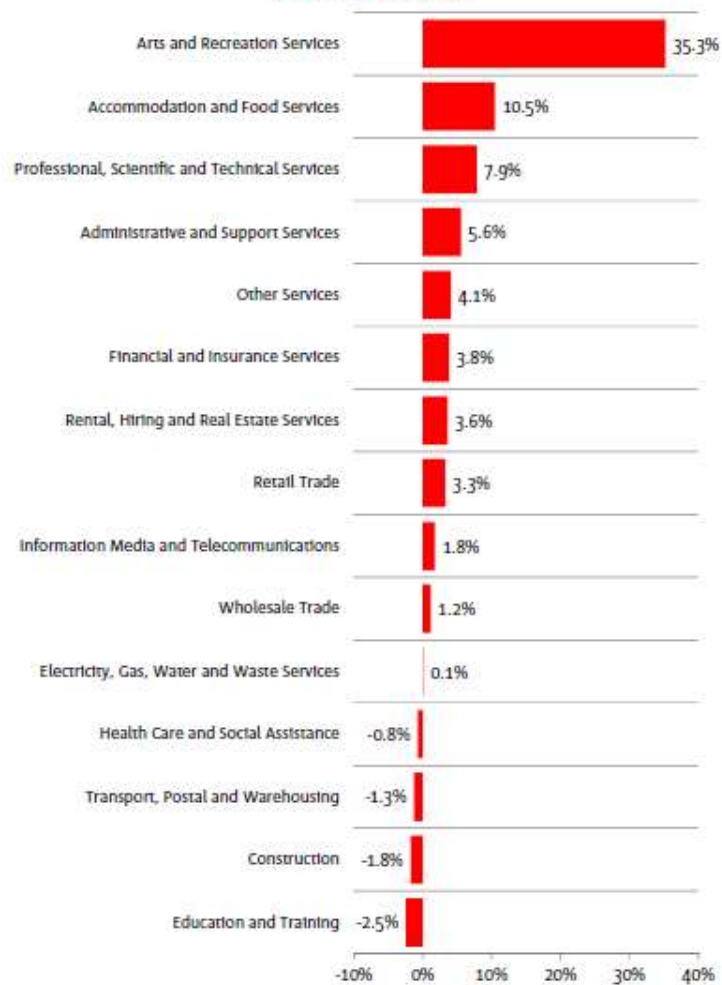
Total Employed



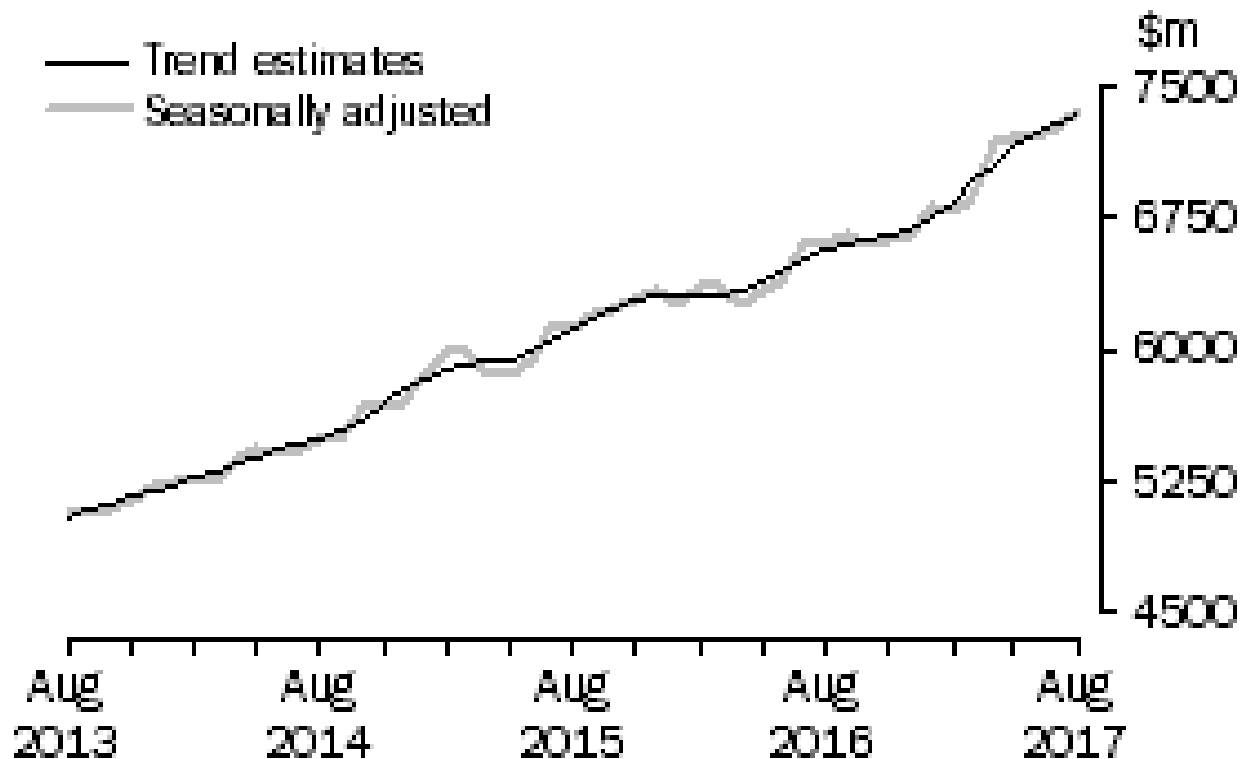
Retail sales' dismal Q3



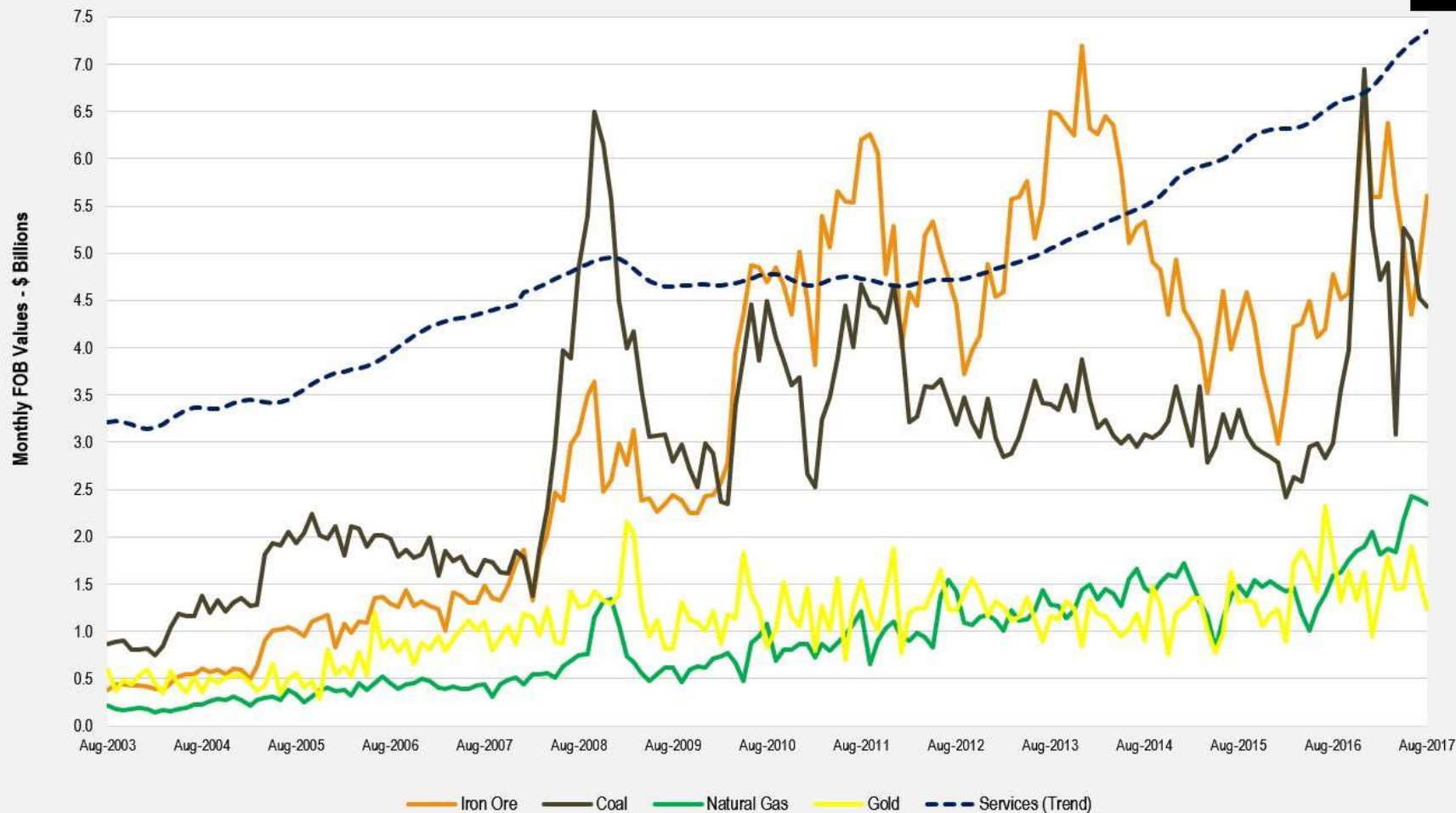
OVERALL GROWTH IN NAB CUSTOMER SPENDING (Q2 2017, % y/y)



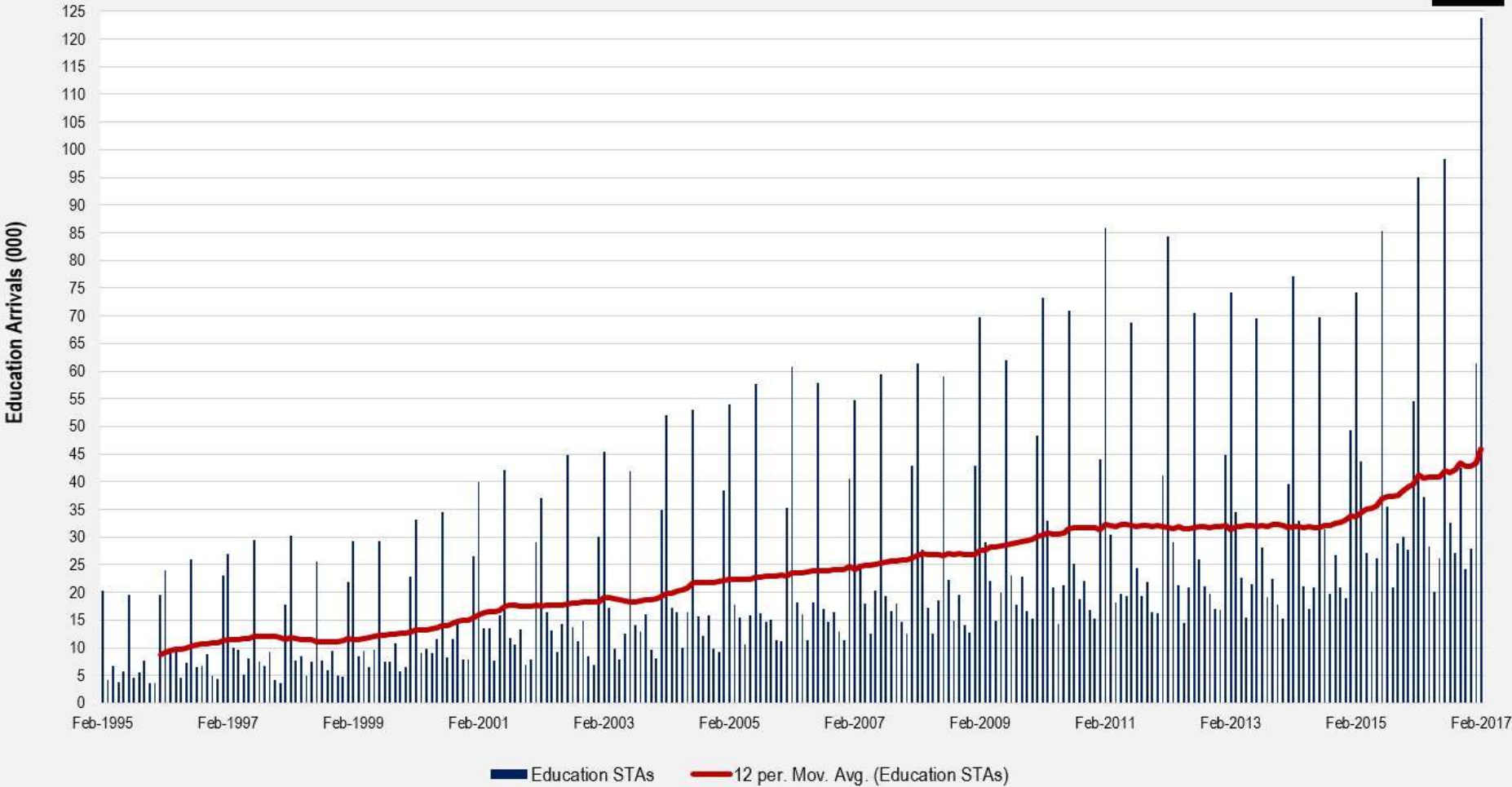

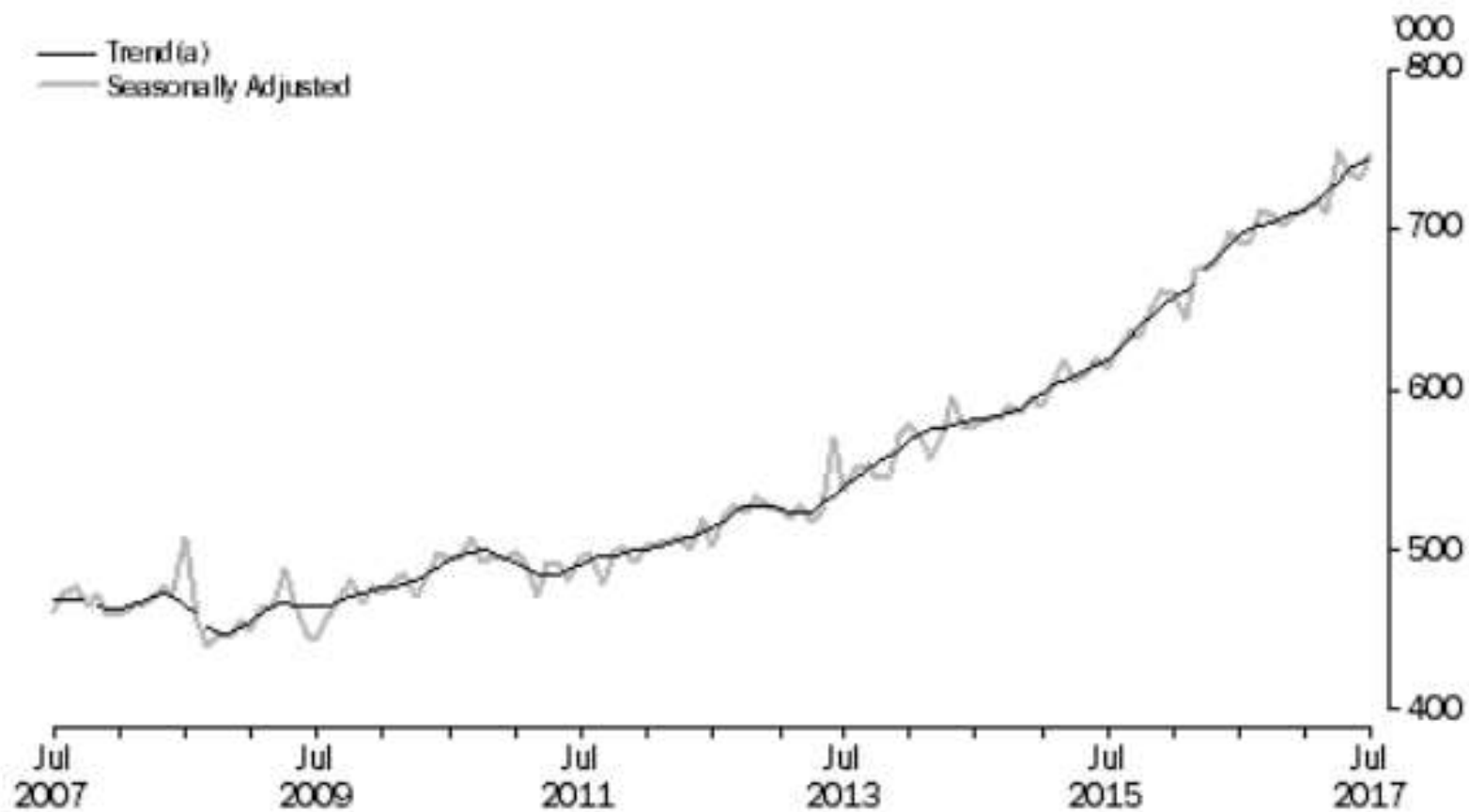

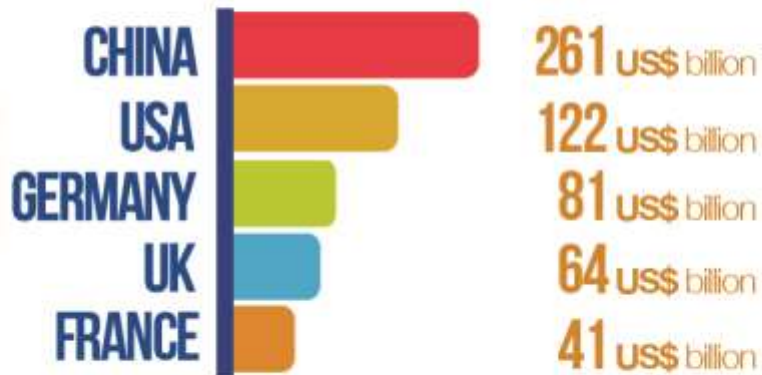

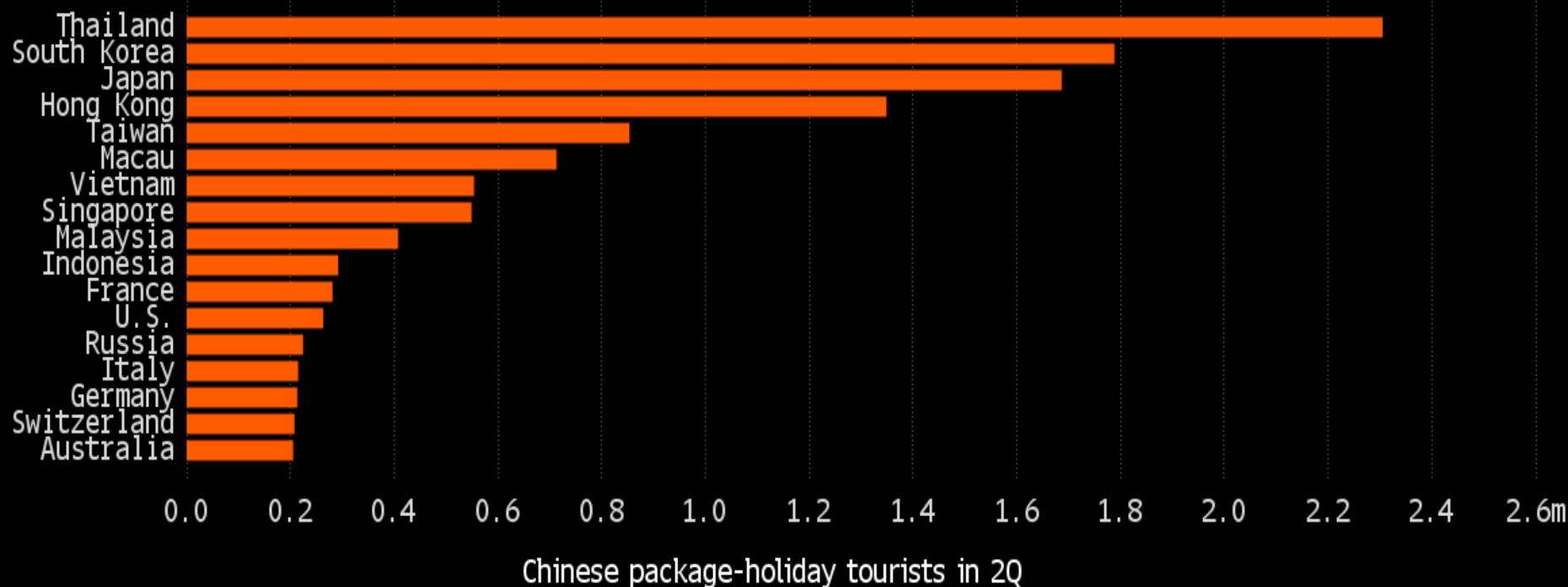
WORLD'S TOP TOURISM SPENDERS
